Trip to the “Bodmin & Wenford Railway” & the ‘South Devon Railway’ on the weekend of the 13th / 14th May 2017.

Coach pick ups on Saturday 13th May:

Weston Super Mare, Locking Rd car park, 8.00 am

Clevedon, First Choice Travel shop, Kenn Rd, 8.45 am

Portishead, Folk Hall, High St, 9.15am.

Itinerary:

Proceeding from Portishead to the Bodmin & Wenford railway, Bodmin, Cornwall, with refreshment stop on route arriving at Bodmin & Wenford at approx 12.45 pm. There is a restaurant, loco sheds and a shop at the station. There will be a heritage diesel train at 1.35pm arriving Wenford at 2 pm. The return diesel train arrives at Bodmin at approx 3pm. We then re-join our coach to drive to Plymouth for our overnight stay. The Jury's Inn hotel offer double, twin & single rooms. The evening is at your own leisure, dinner is available at the hotels at your own expense.

After a buffet style breakfast (included in your price) at the Jury's Inn Hotel, we proceed to Buckfastleigh station (South Devon Railway) which should take approx. 45 mins. We then join the 12.15 train to Totnes where you can either walk into Totnes riverside (Dart river), approx 20 mins walk, or you can catch the train back to Buckfastleigh where you can visit the Rare breeds farm and/or Buckfast butterflies/Dartmoor otter sanctuary (all at additional cost). Once we are all back together (approx 3.45 pm) we set off for our return journey and should arrive back (inc. stops) at approx. 7.00 pm (Portishead), 7.30 pm (Clevedon) and 8.15 pm. (Weston).

The cost of the weekend is **£115** pp. (based on two sharing a double room or a twin room) and single rooms attract a supplement of £15 pp. The cost includes the coach fare, the return journeys on both railways, the hotel accommodation and of course the buffet breakfast.
