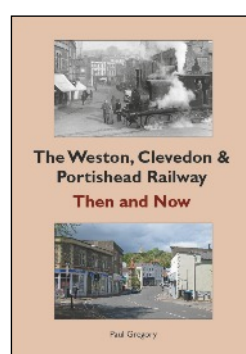
Book: The Weston, Clevedon & Portishead Railway – Then and Now

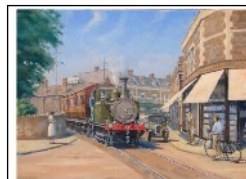

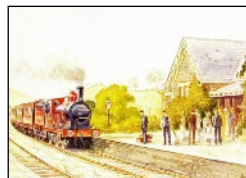

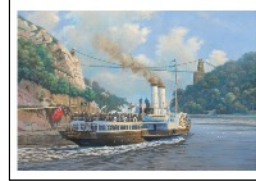

Sheet 2.05 - Portishead (North) 1930

First of three for Portishead. Coverage extends from Rockleigh and Kilkenny Bay and Lake Grounds eastward to Portishead Dock and the shoreline to the east. For full coverage of the Docks, sheet 2.10 is also required. This map does **not** include the WC&P Railway (see 2.10). **Scale approx. 15 inches to a mile.**

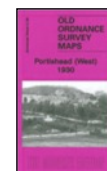

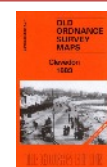

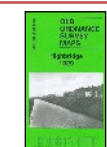

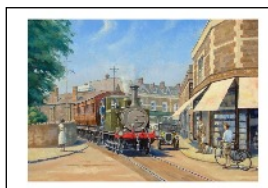

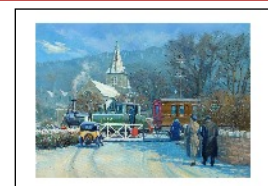
